The discipline "History of the state and law of foreign countries" is a fundamental discipline that belongs to the cycle of professional training of applicants for the first degree of higher education "Bachelor" in the specialty 081 "Law". The purpose of the discipline "History of State and Law of Foreign Countries" is to teach students the general patterns of origin, functioning and development of the state and law of the world's leading countries in their historical specificity and chronological sequence. According to the requirements of the curriculum, students after mastering the credit module must demonstrate the following learning outcomes: knowledge: the basic laws of formation and development of the state and law; system of government and administration in the leading countries of the Ancient World, the Middle Ages, New and Modern times; main sources of slave, feudal and bourgeois law; state and legal institutions in developed countries of Europe, Asia, North America; principles of continental, Anglo-Saxon, etc. systems of bourgeois law; the general structure of the judiciary, police services, prisons of the world's leading countries. experience: preparation for the study of general professional and special legal disciplines; formation of the foundations of professional legal understanding and legal culture of future lawyers on the basis of historical and legal analysis of different stages of world state formation and development of law.

In the 2nd semester, students prepare an essay, the requirements for which are set out in the Guidelines for the preparation of essays on the subject "History of State and Law of Foreign Countries".

During the study of the discipline "History of State and Law of Foreign Countries" applicants for higher education:

- Will be able to use socio-political experience, legal culture of the world's leading countries to build and establish an independent, democratic, legal Ukraine in the world;
 - Gain skills to analyze legislation;
- Will make correct predictions about the development trends of the modern globalized world;
- Will be able to systematize and summarize the current political and legal experience of countries such as England, USA, Germany, France and other countries. in state and legal construction;

- To analyze the practice of parliamentary structures in the leading countries of the world; to reveal the essence of the delegated legislation in England, the USA and other countries at the present stage of their development.

Interdisciplinary links: the discipline "History of State and Law of Foreign Countries" is studied in parallel with the study of disciplines "Theory of State and Law" and "Constitutional Law", which is a necessary prerequisite for effective learning and mastering the material given the system and interconnectedness submission of material with the specified academic disciplines.
