The LAW

In order to gain knowledge and skills to solve difficult life situations or conflicts, which can be regulated by law (contracts, marital and family relations, knowledge of own rights, in particular, in cooperation with law enforcement bodies, etc.). The classes will be:

- Using of current legislation through work with the official site rada.gov.ua.

- Consideration of cases from different branches of law (civil, family, economic, criminal)

- Viewing and discussion of thematic films on human rights

- Acquisition of critical perception skills of political and legal events.

- Teamwork, brainstorming, tasks for legal cases.

Student will be able to see all these issues in general picture only by understanding and mastering the specifics of legal relations in various fields of law, understanding the interaction between the state, a person and citizens, enterprises, institutions, organizations and associations etc.

Communication with the lecturer is possible and will be encouraged on the lectures and practical classes .

In accordance with the requirements of the EPP, the purpose of the discipline is to form students' abilities:

- to abstract thinking, analysis and synthesis (ZK-1);
- to search, process and analyse information from various sources (ZK-3);
- make informed decisions (ZK-7).

As a result of mastering the discipline students will be able to:

- to apply legal provisions, principles and norms.

to exercise their rights and responsibilities as a member of society, realize the value of civil (free democratic) society and the need for its sustainable development, the rule of law, human and civil rights and freedoms in Ukraine.
to understand the basics of legal activity.

- to analyse legal problems, will be able to critically and systematically analyse legal phenomena and will be able to apply the acquired knowledge in life.

- to independently analyse documents, understand their legal nature and significance.

- to work in a team in resolving legal issues.

- to find, process and analyse legal information from various sources.

- to research and exploration, processing and analysis of information on the activities of the state apparatus, the peculiarities of the legal system, to use the theoretical and methodological apparatus of law in the study of state and legal phenomena.
